We oppose slavery and human trafficking in all its forms and make this statement to set out the steps we have taken to ensure that there is no slavery or human trafficking in our business or in our supply chains.

About the Company

Stu Culley Photo Services is an independent company owned by a Sole Trader (Stuart Culley) supplying service and repair of photographic equipment, artwork and photographic images to a wide range of sectors.

The annual turnover is under £36 million. Although I'm not required to make a modern slavery statement under section 54 of the Modern Slavery Act.2015, I'm making this voluntary statement to show my commitment to ethical trading principles.

My commitment to ethical trading

This statement reflects my commitment to acting ethically and with integrity in all of my business relationships and to implementing and enforcing effective systems and controls to ensure slavery and human trafficking is not taking place anywhere in my supply chain.

Due diligence and risk assessment

I vet suppliers and sub-contractors to ensure that they are committed to ethical labour practices.

Training

To ensure a high level of understanding of the risks of Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking in my supply chain, I've watched a number of on-line training session on this subject. For example, i2comply and high speed training.
